General Guidelines

The Carolina Carillon Holiday Parade welcomes your application for the 2010 parade. The parade will begin at approximately 9:45 AM on Saturday, December 4, 2010. The Carolina Carillon is limited to 100 units based upon established entry criteria. The Participation Committee reserves the right to accept or deny any application for entry or to request revisions for designs or plans of any entry accepted. The parade will go on in rain or shine.

Entry Design Information

All units must be designed and decorated to reflect the theme of the parade and must be constructed in a manner which is safe for all participants and spectators. There are occasionally strong winds and wind gusts along the parade route, therefore, each unit should be designed to withstand the elements. All applicants must submit a description and a basic drawing or picture of their unit with the entry application. Float entries must include overall float dimensions and the dimensions and details of props to be used on rental and custom floats.

Feature Presentations

Some talented organizations will present streetside entertainment and performances throughout the parade. However, organizations interested in performing in the parade reviewing area for the WIS-TV telecast must complete and submit the Feature Presentation application by October 16. Auditions are required and must be submitted on DVD with application. Only those organizations selected will be permitted to stop and perform in the reviewing area. Proof of insurance is required with the application.

Customized Floats

All custom floats must be built on a trailer or flatbed with at least two (2) axles, pulled by a separate vehicle unless self-propelled. Pickup trucks, cars, vans, and buses are not floats. Custom float entries must provide their own tow vehicle. A description of the tow vehicle must be included with the entry design information. The tow vehicle must be decorated so that the entire unit has a coordinated appearance and the trailer hitch or attachments must be secure and checked prior to the parade. Proof of insurance is required with the application.

Rental Floats

Full selections of decorated, holiday floats are available on a first-come basis for an additional rental fee of \$500. Please indicate your request for float rental on the application and enclose the additional float rental fee with your parade entry fee. The float rental fee includes signs identifying the organization and a tow vehicle, which is provided. Rental floats must use the tow vehicle provided by our float company.

Cycles and Small Motorized Units

Motorcycles, bicycles, and mini-cars are accepted when part of an organization and only if the motorcycles, bicycles, and mini-cars participate as a performing unit or when the equipment is part of a professional act. Proof of insurance is required with the application.

Cars, Trucks and Vans

An individual vehicle is not eligible to participate unless it is unique (i.e. recognized classic or antique car). Trucks are only used to pull floats. Individuals in the vehicle should be part of the entry presentation and are to sit in the seat of the vehicle. All vehicles and riders are required to have holiday decorations and the number of riders inside the vehicles will be approved by the Participation Committee. Due to safety and insurance requirements, persons are prohibited from riding in the bed of a pickup truck or on the hood or back of a vehicle. All riders must be in the seats; no one can ride up on the back of the rear seat or on the sides of a vehicle.

Marching Units

Any drill team or marching unit (other than bands) will be limited to a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 35 participants. The number of units and placement will be at the discretion of the Participation Committee.

Horses and other Animals

Due to safety and insurance requirements, only organized equestrian units with trained horses and experienced riders will be considered for participation. Riders must maintain a slow pace at all times. Any unit with an animal is 100% responsible for cleaning after the animal. Therefore each animal needs to be diapered. Remember units will be walking, marching, and performing behind you.
